Additionally, we have taken the following steps to secure our operations to continue to meet your sterilization needs:

- Each sterilization location is employing an adjusted shift schedule to minimize overlap between teams.
- We have added health screening of employees and family members, increased sanitation stations and enhanced cleaning protocols of high-risk areas throughout all of our facilities globally.
- We have shifted all possible non-operations staff to work-at-home status to increase social distancing, and to minimize the risk to the rest of the team.

Our continuity plan is constantly being re-evaluated by our team and we are taking all measures we can to minimize the risks associated with this outbreak—without negative impacts or disruptions for our customers.
